


Week 1 (31/03 - 04/04)

Dear Parents,

February was a fantastic month, with various fun-filled and exciting activities! This month we celebrated Yahya's ,Trisha's ,Emma's and Ibrahim's birthdays. I would like to thank the families for their support and for letting us share your child's special day with you!

We have now come to the end of another great topic: 'Land, Air & Water: Transportation' and to the end of a wonderful 'Term 2'. The children had fun learning about land, air and sea transportation. According to the theme, our young learners explored many different types of transportation this month and were able to categorise, distinguish and recognise all forms of transport. We also helped the children learn about different types of jobs related to transportation, such as: bus drivers, pilots, taxi drivers, mechanics, etc. As this is a topic that the children enjoy a lot, they also had a chance to further exercise their language and communication skills by sharing their own experiences. Additionally, we have been playing games, reading books and singing songs about transportation. For example: "Traffic Lights, What Do you Say?" and "The Wheels on the Bus". This encouraged some lovely language and conversation too. \odot

Moreover, our Happy Hippos had loads of fun learning and exploring lots of different sensory activities & materials. We have used various cars, trucks in messy play activities as well, with materials like sand and shaving foam. We have also read exciting stories related to this topic. Moreover, we had an exciting "Road Safety Day": The children learned about traffic lights, pedestrian crossings and many different road signs that we see on a daily basis as we walk or drive to school. Our children are VERY important to us, so we also spoke to them about why it's important to wear helmets while riding a bike, as well as to buckle your seatbelts when you're in a car and why we have to hold an adult's hand when crossing the road, making sure we look left and right \odot .



Mother's Day was a lovely day for all of us too. We prepared something special and unique to bring a smile to all our wonderful TIN mums' faces. On the 20th of March a special activity was organized for the mothers of Happy Hippos.
